## SHORT Film PRODUCTION

JUNE 27th - JULY 7th

8:30am to 2:30pm (no camp July 3rd or 4th)

Over the course of the session, students will learn to write, shoot and edit their own original short film. Focus will be paid to proper writing techniques, directing, camera use, lighting, sound production and post-production using Adobe Creative Suite 6's PREMIERE PRO.



## TV PRODUCTION

JULY 10th - JULY 18th

8:30am to 2:30pm

Over the course of the session, students will learn to develop, pre-produce & produce an original television show. The shows can be news, entertainment, sports or children's programming. All aspects of production will be covered including scripting, casting, acting, lighting, sound design and graphics.



## MUSIC VIDEO PRODUCTION

JULY 31st - AUGUST 8th

8:30am to 2:30pm

For the duration of the session, students will be fully immersed in the various aspects of producing and directing a music video. By the end of the program, each student edits their own version of a short music video subject that was conceived, produced, and shot by larger groups within the class.



### PREMIERE NIGHT (AUGUST 8th)

On the evening of the last day of camp, we will premiere select videos from all three sessions in the Jackson Liberty Auditorium at 6pm. Black Tie Optional.
